Leadership Report

Summary of the July 2024 Leadership Board Meeting

Pastor Rachel Stockle

Marian Sorenson serves as secretary

Susan Kissick serves as Lay Leader

Lee and Leah Hanlin were approved as new board members replacing Steven Maxwell. They will share the responsibilities for one position on the board. Lee was present at this meeting.

The Leadership Board approved the use of the Cory Fund to subsidize expenses related to the music program as needed.

It was approved that the Financial Secretary can transfer up to \$10,000 per month as needed to pay for church expenses. Any transfer of funds must be noted on the next financial statement given to the Leadership Board.

The Board approved a document outlining the Germann Fund and clarifies the use of these funds.

It was suggested that the Money Market funds which are dormant (i.e. puppet, labyrinth) be used for other purposes (i.e. radio broadcast). Additional discussions will be held to determine if this is a viable use of these funds.

A question was raised about missing out on cash donations due to a collection not being taken during worship. The Worship Committee meets in August and will discuss this issue.

A quarterly financial update is to be given to the congregation.

There will be a Town Hall meeting before Consecration Sunday. (Date TBD)

A new line item in the worship section of the budget will be created for the licenses required for livestreaming.

The spire has been repaired

The work of the Ad-Hoc committee for building security is moving forward.

The cleaning for the kitchen has been completed at a cost of \$1125. The cost will be split between the UWF and the church.

The Internal Accounting Controls document was presented. It will be reviewed by the Board at the August meeting.

The Jason Gray concert did not break even. Each of the three UMCs owes \$2167.06. It was approved to take this money out of the Cory Fund.

The Board approved a bridge loan of \$5000 for the Bright Start Preschool.

The Nominating Committee has recommended the following slate of members for the Leadership Board

2025: Nancy Ogle, Jim Sours, Lee / Leah Hanlin

2026: Fae Jones, Clif Weisinger, Julie Brink

2027: Dikki Andrews, Brad Billings, Cathy Staff

There will be only one worship service on September 8 at 10:00. At 11:00 there will be a Back-to-School party with food, games, crafts, etc.

Charge Conference will be held at 1:30 on October 27 at Melrose Chapel.

Bight Start Preschool at Vermont Street United Methodist Church is now enrolling for the 2024-2025 school year!




Gathering Place Hosts
