- B) During Sept. we will be collecting bedding for Sleep in Heavenly Peace
- C) Brad Billings is going to contact QU and Culver to ask for assistance to aid in the formation and implementation of a marketing plan.
- **D)** There will be an Estate Planning seminar on September 7 at noon presented by Ed Weston, Development Director of the Preacher's Aid Society.
- E) VSUMC Town Hall meetings will occur on July 20 at 10:00 and at 12:00 to discuss operating income and expenses.

Generative and Strategic Work

Annual Conference Reports:

Cathy Staff and Pastor Rachel reported on Annual Conference. Four main issues Pastor Rachel identified were:

- 1. A standing rule that provides clergy receiving new appointments to be granted the last two weeks (including two Sundays) a release from all pastoral responsibilities
- 2. The Conference approved the budget for 2026, a reduction of \$408,853 from 2025
- 3. The annual conference also approved an increase to the health insurance allowance to \$20,000 paid to full-time pastors for 2026
- 4. The new clergy retirement plan, Compass, will be implemented Jan. 1, 2026.

A summary of Annual Conference can be found at 2025 IGRC Annual Conference Summary

Radio Ministry:

All money from the Labyrinth Money Market fund will be transferred to the Radio Ministry. This was previously approved at the August 2024 meeting. The contract for WGEM to broadcast the late-night Christmas Eve service was approved by consensus. \$849 covers broadcasting from 10:30 – midnight, and a number of promotional spots

Insurance:

The Building and Grounds Committee recommended and the LB approved that VSUMC change insurance companies to Brotherhood Mutual. The premium will be \$45, 894, a savings of \$10,335 this year.

H. Staffing:

Rob Davis has been hired through Man Power for 30 hours per week. He started June. 23 Glenda Cox, the new financial manager will begin work on June 30. Al Jones will continue to work one or two days a week at his current hourly wage. Still needed are a youth minister, tech support, and a drummer for the 11:00 service

I. Roof Repair:

Building and Grounds Committee recommended and the LB approved the contract with Kerberg Roofing to repair the sanctuary roof.


