- 3. Determine the best way to increase children and youth ministry

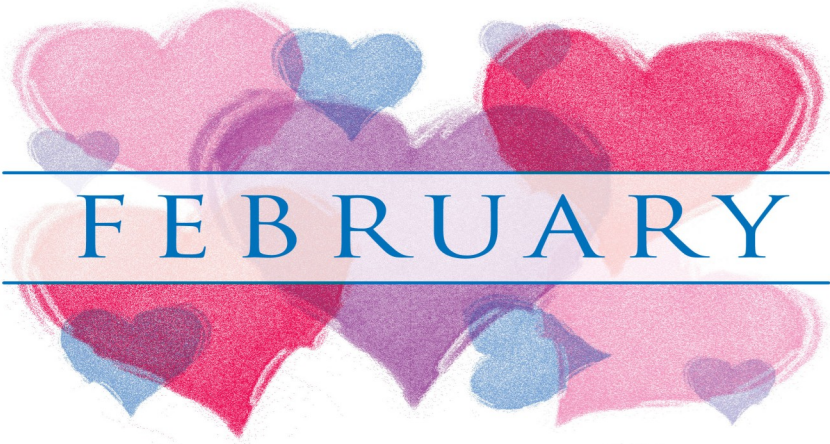
Leadership Board Goals

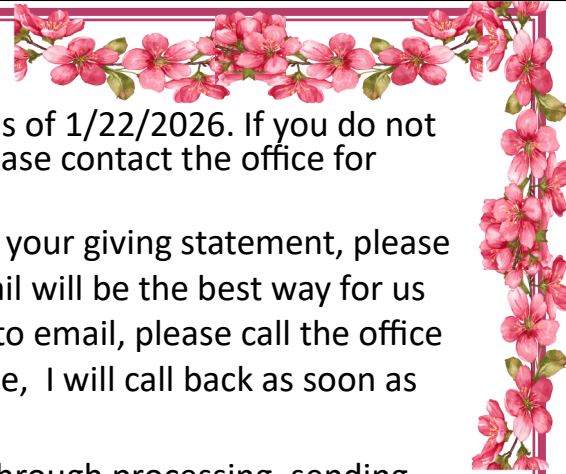
2025 Giving Statements

We help people in the Quincy area through our participation in this organization.

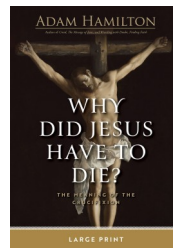
SHEPHERDS FUND
